#### **Agenda Discussed:**

1. Review of Current Facilities for Divyang Students/Staff: The committee reviewed existing facilities, such as ramp access, wide doorways, and restroom modifications. It was noted that signage and tactile markers are limited, and digital materials are not fully accessible.

#### 2. Identifying Gaps and Challenges

Physical Accessibility Gaps: Lack of braille signage, absence of designated seating areas, no tactile indicators on staircases, and narrow entrances to some labs.

Digital Accessibility Gaps: No screen reader compatibility in online learning materials; absence of recorded lectures or captioning for hearing-impaired students.

Emotional & Academic Support Gaps: Limited staff training on how to address Divyang needs; no regular counseling or peer support system.

Decision: Prioritize immediate, short-term changes (signage, software) and plan longer-term infrastructure changes over six months.

#### 3. Recommendations and Proposals

Infrastructure Recommendations: Install braille signs at classrooms, restrooms, and entrances. Create at least one accessible workstation in each computer lab. Set up designated seating areas in classrooms.

Assistive Technology Recommendations: Purchase and install screen reader software on library and lab computers. Provide magnifying software for low-vision students.

Support and Awareness Recommendations: Conduct sensitization workshops for faculty and students on interacting respectfully and helpfully with Divyang peers. Appoint one counselor as the Divyang student advisor.

Decision: The committee will prepare a budget proposal and submit it to the institution management within two weeks.

#### 4. Assigning Committee Responsibilities

Infrastructure improvements: Chairperson (Dr. Sayali Pande) will coordinate with the administration.

Assistive tools & digital resources: Member Secretary (Shikha Sharda) will research vendors and procurement options.

Training and awareness sessions: Member (Monika Karve) will design the workshop plan and identify external resource persons.

#### **Resolutions Passed:**

- 1. Conduct a detailed accessibility audit within two weeks.
- 2. Draft and submit a budget and action plan to the management by the end of July.
- 3. Launch sensitization and awareness workshops for faculty, staff, and students in August.
- 4. Equip at least one lab with assistive technology tools within the next two months.
- 5. Schedule next meeting to assess progress and discuss long-term plans.
